- Small Business (SB) Concern
Small Business Concern means a concern, including its affiliates, that is independently owned and operated, not dominant in the field of operation in which it is working on Government Contracts. Small Disadvantaged Business (SDB) Concern\*
A small business that is at least 51% owned and controlled by a socially and economically disadvantaged individual or individuals. African Americans, Asian Pacific Americans, Subcontinent Asian Americans, and Native Americans are presumed to qualify. All individuals must have a net worth of less than \$750,000, excluding the equity of the business and primary residence. The firm has either received certification as a small disadvantaged business by the Small Business Administration (SBA) or self-certifies that it meets the requirements of a small disadvantaged business.

A small business, whose principle office is located within a HUBZone and 35% of its employees are also located in a HUBZone. The firm has received its certification from the Small Business Administration (SBA).
